### Editorial:


Yesterday the WhatsApp postings began with warnings about Covid-19 scam emails and texts. They appear to be from reputable services (GOV.UK, Amazon, PayPal, NHS, the Information Commissioner – ICO.ORG) and try to bait you with “urgent” requests to confirm your identity. Of course their real aim is to steal your identity and scam you. Please be very wary of these and don’t click anything until you are certain. I do my best to check every link before I post it, so hopefully things from my account are OK. However, if in doubt – ring me!

With more residents out and about, the problem of dog mess caused much annoyance to the group. As you can imagine my eyes are tuned to it as I walk the verges each day, and it has been noticeable that the problem has increased in the last week. It is very disappointing in a Village like ours, especially at a time like this. I can only assume that it is someone now laid off work, or working from home, that has been caught out without a bag. A gentle word of warning to them if they are reading, we always catch persistent offenders! The intelligence network in the Village is that good. The regular dog community know each other well and all behave responsibly.

Supermarkets are all adopting different approaches to the Covid-19 situation, different queuing systems, different distancing policies and different rationing rules. There were some distressing stories yesterday about Tesco, Waitrose and Sainsbury. Our advice would be to check the web site of your supermarket to find out what is happening before you leave home. Even then, local management may have local policies in place. I have put links to the major supermarkets below. Interestingly, at 06:00 this morning, I was placed in a queue just to visit the Morrison’s home page and it took 2 minutes to load. Once I got there the messages were just an apology for the problems with no information on their policies. Steer clear of their folks!

### Nationally:

- UK deaths from Covid-19 grew by 180 yesterday to 1,408. That is a drop for the second day in a row. It is still too early to tell where the curve is going but the signs are good.
