
Nationally:

- UK deaths from Covid-19 grew by 563 yesterday to 2,352. That is another a huge increase. Unfortunately, if you look at hospital admissions for yesterday, we need to brace ourselves for a steadily rising figure for the next few days. The "green shoots" that were talked about in the press briefings on Tuesday seem to have been stunted by the frost! You'll see from the chart that we will shortly overtake China. There is also talk of at least 1 in 40 of the population having already caught the virus. This emphasises the importance of social distancing. To put this chart in context, the UK population is estimated at 66 million, Italy is 61 million, Spain is 47 million and China is 1,439 million.
